

Poster Presentation Guidelines

Posters will be on display throughout the day. There are two special poster sessions from **13:00 to 14:00** and from **15:30 to 16:00**. Authors are expected to stand near their posters throughout these two poster sessions.

The following information should be helpful when designing your poster:

- Each author will be assigned an A0 size (841 x 1189 mm) poster board (landscape).
- Posters will be mounted on the poster board with Velcro and sticky tape, which will be provided.
- The abstract title, author, and affiliation should be indicated in a heading at the top of your poster.
- The title line(s) should be readable from at least 2 metres away - lettering should be at least 2.5 cm high.
- The presentation must be readable from a distance, so please use an appropriately sized font.
- Keep visual materials simple and clear. Try not to use too much printed text; graphs, charts, tables and pictures should be used to communicate information where possible.
- Simple use of colour can add effective emphasis.
- You might wish to consider providing handouts during the presentation.
