Anyone wishing to propose a paper for consideration should submit an abstract in English to the planning committee by sending an e-mail attachment to icsiabstracts@ulster.ac.uk before **31 March 2011**. Notification of acceptance will be sent by 31 May 2011.

Format of abstracts

Abstracts (c. 300 words excluding any reference list) should be prepared for blind refereeing as a Word file.

Select one of the conference themes and cite this before the title of your paper.

Include your surname and ICSI abstract in the subject entry of your email message.

No name or designation should appear on the abstract.
