



QUIET PERIOD

SUMMER EXAMINATIONS 2012

In order not to disturb examinations or disturb students' private study and revision time, all members of the University community are asked to observe the Quiet Period. This will commence one week prior to the examination period and will apply in any college or other venue close to examination rooms and residential or study accommodation.

No noisy activities may take place on campus from **16 April to 25 June 2012**. The exceptions to this are the Sports Centre, or by special negotiation and for short periods, in the Great Hall Complex.

Colleges or societies wishing to organise events during the Quiet Period must seek special permission from the relevant College Dean, the University Dean or the Head of Student Registry.

This ban includes noise of unreasonable volume and at unreasonable times within residences. It is especially important at this time that residents are able to study in peace.

Any unnecessary noise during this period carries hefty fines and will be enforced by the Deanery.
