Welcome to the Anglican & Free Church* (AFC) Chapel. Sunday Morning Worship begins at 11.30am. Our community is made up of people from many different Christian groups and our worship seeks to incorporate aspects of that diversity.

Our opening worship, usually begins jointly with the Roman Catholics in the concourse area between the chapels. We also share the whole service with the Roman Catholics when we have 'United Worship'.

After worship, we usually have lunch in the Chaplaincy Lounge / Restaurant, sometimes a cooked meal, sometimes bread and cheese. Cost is usually £2.50. It is a great opportunity to meet and to get to know one another. A vegetarian option is always available, if you have other dietary requirements, please talk to one of the chaplains and we will try and meet your needs.
